e.g.: Visualize the budget data of various public departments of the government, allowing citizens to suggest how to use the budget effectively

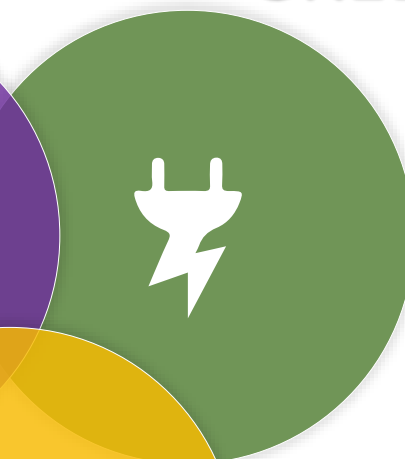
OPEN X GREEN

e.g.: Jointly create a net-zero emission method by local residents and relevant stakeholders

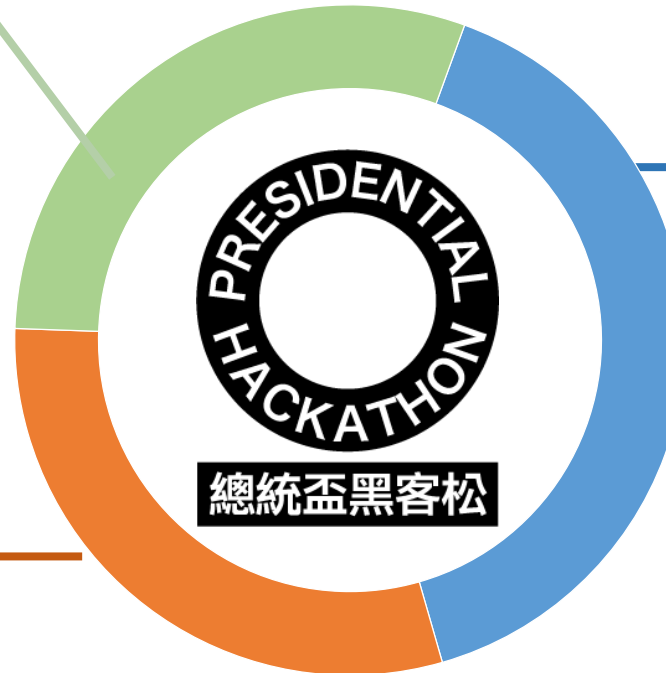
